#### CONCISE ALLEGATION FOR FCC REVIEW

I request FCC review of the reported operation identified above. The complaint alleges transmission on CB Channel 38, 27.385 MHz, using an amateur-service transceiver at approximately 100 watts. The linked YouTube video is cited as supporting evidence. This statement presents allegations for investigation and does not claim that the FCC has already made a finding.

### 3. POTENTIALLY APPLICABLE FCC RULES

#### 47 C.F.R. Sec. 95.935 - Unauthorized use of non-CBRS transmitters.

Prohibits using a transmitter intended for the Amateur Radio Service, and not certified for CBRS, to communicate on CB channels. Subsection (b) treats such operation as unauthorized under 47 U.S.C. Sec. 301.

#### 47 C.F.R. Sec. 95.967 - CBRS transmitter power limits.

Limits CB power to 4 W mean carrier for AM or FM and 12 W peak envelope power for SSB. Alleged 100 W operation exceeds either applicable limit.

#### 47 C.F.R. Sec. 95.905 - Authority voided by operating-rule violations.

A person's license-by-rule authority to operate a CBRS station is voided if the person violates the CBRS operating rules.
